



### **In Tribute to former Chairman Maurice C. Robinson**

It is with deep respect and profound gratitude that VM Wealth Management Limited (VMWM) acknowledges the passing of Mr. Maurice C. Robinson, former Chairman of VMWM. Mr. Robinson was also a former Director of the VM Building Society (VMBS). A highly accomplished attorney-at-law and dedicated public servant, he played a transformational role in the development of the VM Group and the broader Jamaican financial services industry.

Mr. Robinson's leadership at VMWM was marked by strategic foresight, unwavering integrity, and a deep commitment to nation-building. As Chairman, he guided the organisation through key periods of growth and transition, helping to shape its operating philosophy and strengthen its governance framework. His contributions extended beyond boardrooms - his vision helped to empower individuals and build stronger communities through access to financial opportunities.

In recognition of his legacy and commitment to education, VM Investments Limited, parent company of VMWM, in partnership with the VM Foundation and the University of the West Indies Development and Endowment Fund (UWIDEF), launched the '*VM Investments Limited – Maurice C. Robinson Business Management and Economics Scholarship*' in 2021. This scholarship supports students at The University of the West Indies who are pursuing degrees in Business, Management, Data Analytics/Data Science, and Economics - fields that reflect Mr. Robinson's belief in the power of knowledge to uplift lives and transform societies.

Outside of his contributions to the VM Group, Mr. Robinson was a Partner at the law firm Myers, Fletcher & Gordon, with a distinguished legal career spanning more than six decades. He was admitted to the Jamaican Bar in

1959 and to the UK as a Solicitor in 1977. His practice areas included Commercial Law, Trademarks, Patents, Trusts, and Estates. He also served as Chairman of the Public Utility Commission from 1972 to 1977, during a critical phase in the development of Jamaica's regulatory landscape.

A man of deep wisdom, quiet strength, and purpose-driven leadership, Mr. Maurice C. Robinson will be remembered as a trailblazer who helped lay the foundation for a stronger, more inclusive financial ecosystem in Jamaica.
